Why do so many sexual assault cases fall through the judicial cracks? Studies show that only a handful of sexual assault cases are reported to police, few make it to court and even fewer end in a conviction. Jane Ursel's ground breaking study of sexual assault cases reported to the Winnipeg police in 2015 and 2016 begins to provide some answers to why so many cases fall out of the system. She will present a preliminary analysis of her work.
